Speaking of our next meeting... The first meeting of the month is our business meeting. Don't forget to pay your monthly invoice!



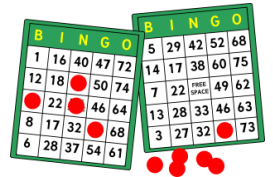
Speaker Mark Flowers
